# At Arrival



- Every visitor, at the Reception, will be provided with:
  - Face mask
  - Gloves
  - Hand sanitizer
- Thermo scanners will be available at reception for everyone's safety. Visitors with body temperature above 37.5° will not be allowed to enter the SimCenter\*
- Visitors must comply with C-19 Background Assessment (written confirmation)



\* Please note that temperature and other personal data will not be recorded or stored at VI-grade. This is a GO-NO GO test.

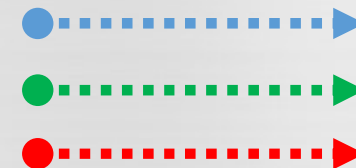
# Access to Simulator Rooms



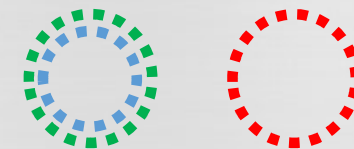
- We created a procedure that allows driver, accompanying staff (i.e. other drivers, engineers, ...) and VI-grade personnel to reach their locations following different paths, hence maximizing social distance.

- These paths will be identified with different colors:

- |                              |                       |

| • DRIVER                     | to the Simulator Room |
| • ACCOMPANYING STAFF (max 3) | to the Meeting Room   |
| • VI-grade PERSONNEL         | to the Control Room   |



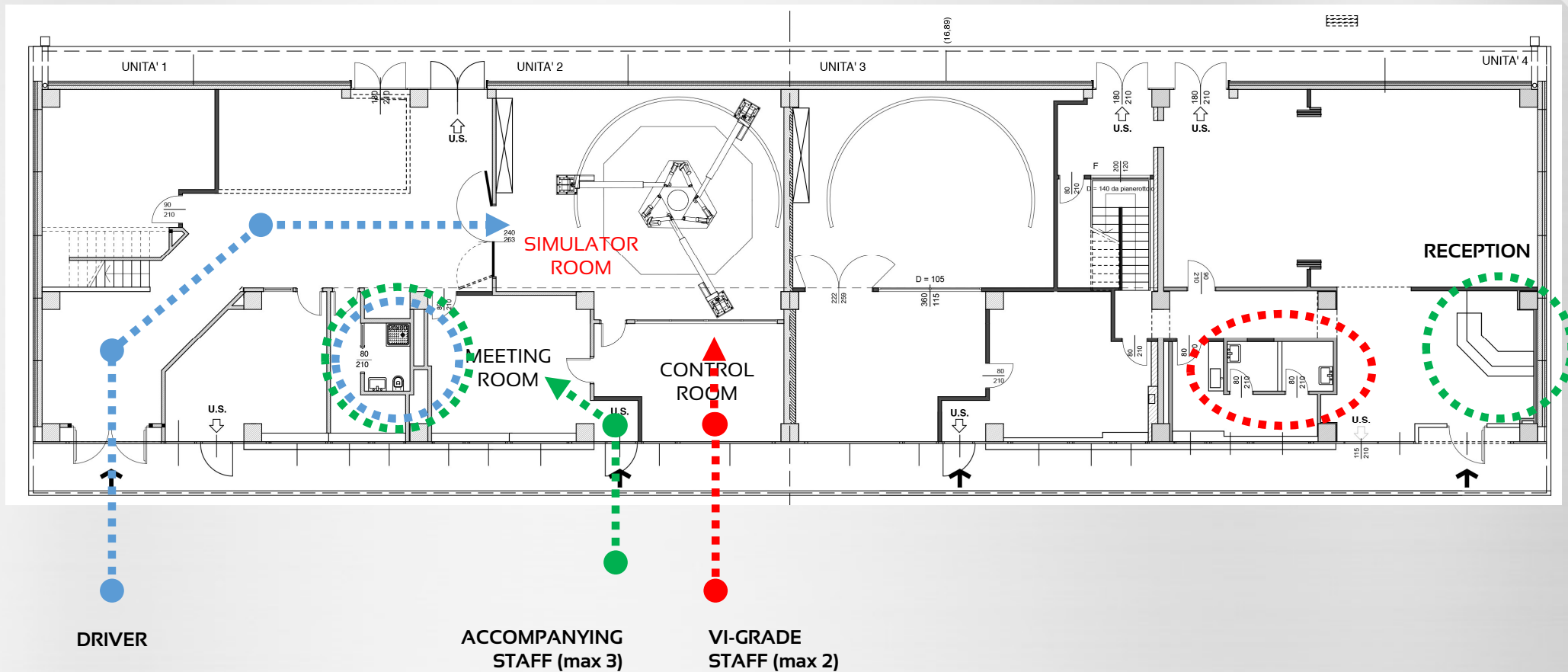
- Simulator seats protected with single-use plastic cover
- Separate restrooms for Customers and VI-grade Staff
- Colored tapes on the floor will identify different paths to be followed:



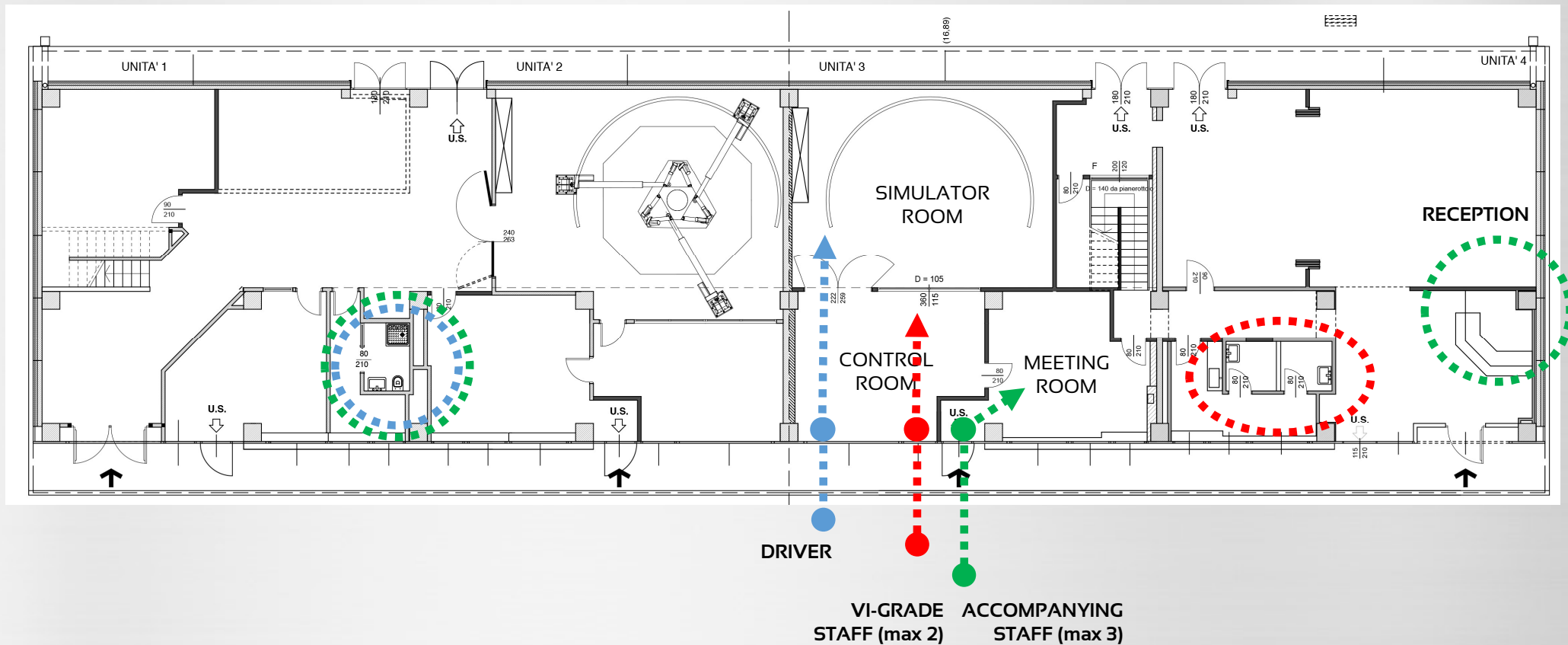
- LIGHT BLUE for Driver
- GREEN for accompanying staff
- RED for VI-grade personnel

- Seat is protected with a single-use plastic cover

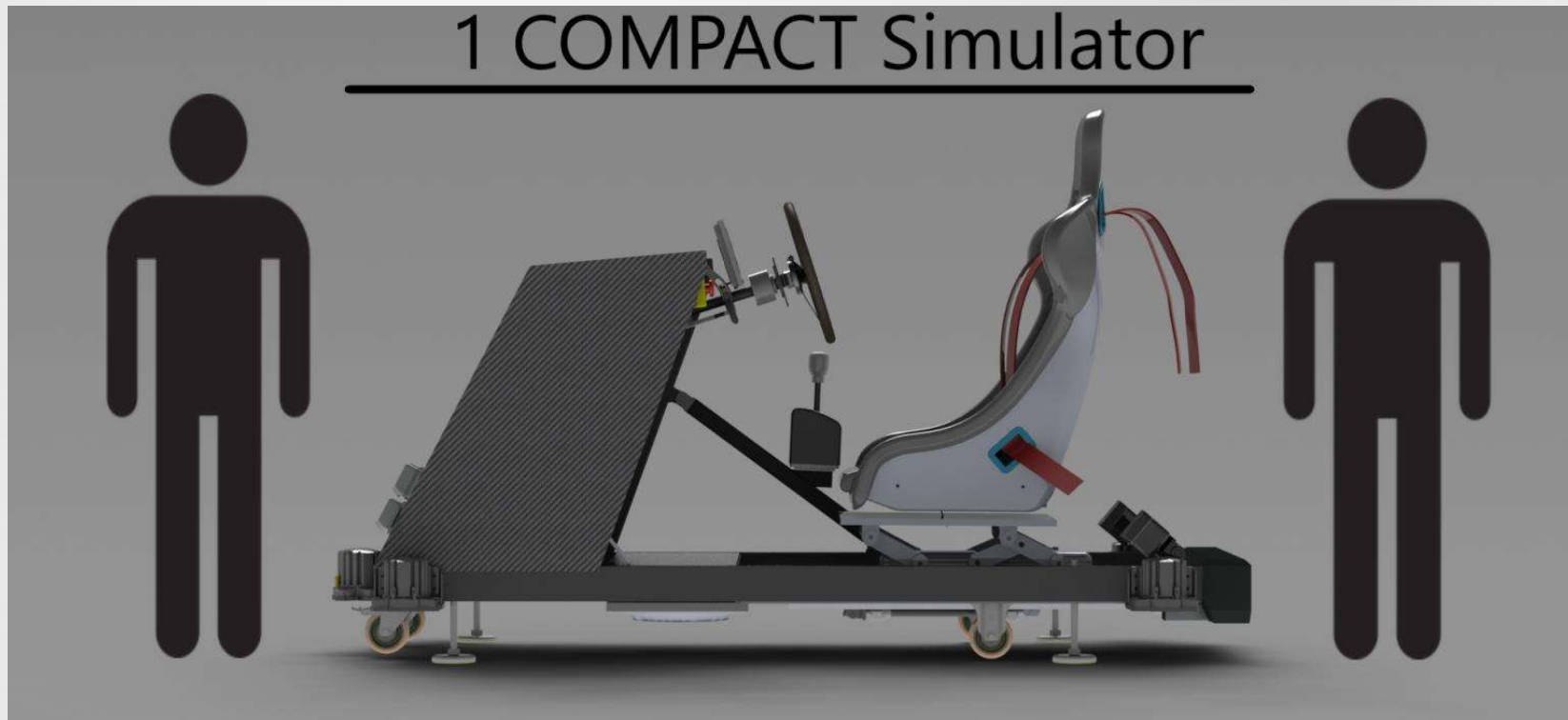




# Social Distance
